# Lottery for workforce rentals in Hauppauge

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The [Long Island Housing Partnership](#) will hold a lottery Tuesday for the workforce rental residences at a new Hauppauge apartment community.

The new \$30 million rental complex for people age 55 and over, called the [Cornerstone at Hauppauge](#), welcomed its first residents last week.

The development, built by Farmingdale-based Terwilliger & Bartone Properties, has 98 apartments on 9 acres off Joshua's Path in Hauppauge. The lottery for the 10 percent of apartments priced as workforce housing will be held at 4 p.m. at Islip Town Hall East at 655 Main St. in Islip.

Amenities at the Cornerstone at Hauppauge include a 3,000-square-foot clubhouse with fireplace, dining room, library, fitness center and outdoor recreation area.

The development's first phase features one-bedroom apartments that are now available for occupancy. Phase two of the development will offer two-bedroom apartments, and will be ready for occupancy in March 2020.
